## RV PARKING AT GEAR: Working with what we have

What could be better than camping with friends in the Greater Asheville Area in Autumn?



All RVs will enter the Ag Center grounds through Gate 7 off 280/Airport Road.

Please do not arrive before your assigned date!

- **1.PLAN ON: Uneven sites**. Bring leveling Blocks, pads, or wood planks.
- **2.PLAN ON:** Water source being a distance from your RV. Bring extra length of water hose and a Y to split the water supply to share with your neighbor. Note that the water at the campsites is Posted "non-potable water". We were advised that the water is Asheville city water, but the NC Department of Agriculture required the Ag Center to label them as non-potable because they are frost free spigots. You only can make the determination to drink the water. PLEASE consider bringing your own drinking /cooking water.
- **3.PLAN ON: Electric source being a distance from your RV.** Electric pedestals are scattered and offer 50/30/20-amp service. Have extra power extension cords; and it won't hurt to have an adapter.
- **4.PLAN ON:** Sewer sites that may need to be shared or are distance from your RV. Bring an extra length sewer hose.
- **5.PLAN ON:** Coming to the WNC Ag Center with *a full tank of fresh water on board*, and *empty grey/black tanks*.
- **6.PLAN ON: Being patient with the parkers** who have a challenging job getting everyone parked safely. It will take extra time to get folks parked.
- **7.PLAN ON: HAVING A GREAT TIME!** IF you want to park with friends, you need to come together, have the same date of entry and same type of camping. ie. FHUs, dry camping or electric only. The size of your rig may also dictate your parking position.

Note: There may be additional electric sites available depending on how parking is done. We will do all that can be done to get folks hooked up to electric.

**Note:** Items 2 & 4 apply to Full Hook ups only.
